Psalm 13

☞ Lament—too Long (vv. 1-2)

What is the problem? We don't know

Who are the enemies? We aren't sure

How long has this lasted? We don't know

Blessed are those who mourn for they will be comforted" (Matthew 5:4)

☞ Prayer—give Light (vv. 3-4)

"Enlighten me, LORD my God"

God's work on the inside is more important than any changes he can bring to the outside.

☞ Chased—unfailing Life (vv. 5-6)

The New Testament word = Agape

"Steadfast love" = He is enough

Psalm 27— Wait for the Lord

2. How would you describe the process of this Psalm? What does the progression teach you?
3. If waiting on God is a sign of growth and maturity, how are you doing in your relationship with the Lord? Why?
