Question to Ask About Whether a Church Should Continue Its Ministry:

If the church closed its doors for good would anyone in the community around it notice or care?

Leviticus 19:18 prompts 2 questions:

1) What does it mean to love someone? 2) And who is your neighbor? Love: an action, from God, reflects God.

Neighbor: the people beyond you

How do you go about loving your neighbor?


