* CLOSE Up (vv. 26-27)

- ✓ The Spirit in you HELPS
“come to my aid”
- ✓ The Spirit in you prays
“groans too deep for words” (ESV)
- ✓ The Spirit in you KNOWS
“the will of God”

* BACK Up (vv. 28-30)

- ✓ God SEES you beginning to end
“called, justified and glorified at the same time”
- ✓ God SHAPES you beginning to end
“bring to complete at the Day” (Philippians 1:6, ESV)
- ✓ God WORKS for the good beginning to end
My part—love God
God's part — according to his purpose
