## Hebrews 1:1-4

- One Way

“in many times and in many ways” (v.1)

Compare to the one and only Son

- Seven Complete

1) Heir - supreme place

2) Creation - made the universe

3) Radiance - presence of God

4) Representation - bears the stamp

5) Sustains all things - Atlas

6) Purification - removes sin

7) Majesty - right hand of God

- One Better

“superior to the angels” (v.4)

Better . . . things, hope, covenant, promises, sacrifice, etc.

“Name” - Lion of Judah, Prince of Peace, Alpha & Omega,

Savior and LORD

“Let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith.”

(Hebrews 12:1b-2)
