The need — a renewed connection to Jesus

Hebrews 1:4-14

How many Americans believe in angels? (75%)

*Angels are amazing

✓ They worship ✓ They are supernatural ✓ They serve

How many Americans believe in the deity of Jesus? (56%)

*The Son of God is Superior

✓ Son vs servant ✓ Worshipped vs worshipper

✓ On the Throne vs around the Throne

✓ Creator vs created ✓ Victor vs victorious

“Therefore, holy brothers and sisters, who share in the heavenly calling, fix your thoughts on Jesus, whom we acknowledge as our apostle and high priest.” (Hebrews 3:1)

Reflective Questions:

- 1) How do you think you might react if you saw an angel? What do you believe about angels?
- 2) What is the relationship of Jesus and the angels? Are there similarities; differences? What makes Jesus superior?
- 3) Why is our connection to Jesus so important? What happens if it is weakened? What does it mean to “fix your thoughts on Jesus?”
