## Hebrews 2:1-9

### Don’t Drift (Hebrews 2:1-4)

What does drifting away look like?

Drifting requires no effort

Drifting is never intentional

Drifting never happens upstream

Drifting’s speed increases downstream

Drifting causes problems for other vessels

Drifting always ends in shipwreck

“Watch your life and doctrine closely. Persevere in them, because if you do, you will save both yourself and your hearers.” 1st Timothy 4:16

### Who Are We? (Hebrews 2:5-8)

“God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus.” Ephesians 2:6

Thematic movement: humiliation → redemption → glorification → dominion

### But We See Jesus (Hebrews 2:9)

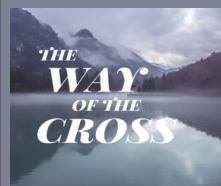
What we see around us is rarely a reflection of the truest reality in life.
