One Greater Than . . . (vv. 5-10)

- ✓ The Messiah appointed high priest
“in the order of Melchizedek” (7:3) The key word = forever
- ✓ Compassion so real, willing to die
“prayer and petitions . . .” all because of reverent submission
“Thy will be done”
- ✓ One example to follow
“learned obedience”
The perfect sacrifice → “eternal salvation”
- * The pathway to maturity is surrender & suffering.
