STEPPING DOWN

The road that Jesus invites us to journey is not a path we would naturally take, but it is the road he traveled.

Luke 17:1-10

The travelers are called unworthy servants.

1st Step = Watch Yourself

“Pay attention to yourselves!” (v.3, ESV)

- Your understanding of yourself is crucial.

It takes humility.

2nd Step = Confrontation/restoration

Matthew 18:15 and Galatians 6:1

- It is best done by getting lower.

You must forgive them.

3rd Step = Enough faith

It seemed like an impossible standard.

- “You don’t need more faith . . .” (MSG Paraphrase)

Our faith seems more stagnant

4th Step = Called to serve

Humble servants willing to do their duty.

- “The greatest among you will be the servant of all.”

Reflective Questions:

- 1) What has been a favorite hike or walk you have enjoyed? Why?
- 2) It is helpful to discuss the passage first: What aspect of Jesus’ teaching makes the most sense to you; the least sense to you? What are your conclusions?
- 3) What aspect of humility needs attention in your life?
