A FAITHFUL LIFE: Let's Begin

As we launch our fall sermon series this morning, I want us to realize how terroristic and aggressive Nebuchadnezzar's takeover must have been for the people of Judah. The Book of Daniel begins with chaos and deportation.

Daniel 1:1-7

History — "in this world you will have trouble"

In 605 BC, the newly crowned king of Babylon besieges Jerusalem.

Verse 2: "The LORD delivered the king of Judah . . . "

Leviticus 26 records God's warning

2 Kings 20:16-18 tells us what the Prophet Isaiah said to Hezekiah in 700 BC. It is fulfilled as we begin the Book of Daniel.

* Culture — "do not conform to the pattern of this world"

"squeezed into its mold"

The realities of Babylon would include <u>many gods, magic, immorality, dictatorship . . .</u>

Daniel and his friends follow the words of Jeremiah 29:4-7
