Jesus' Predictions . . .

1st The Future of this World (vv. 5-11)

"In this world you will have trouble."

This is a fallen world.

2nd The Future Heroes (vv. 12-19)

They will be my witnesses.

You will not perish

3rd The Future Repeated (vv. 20-24)

This will mirror future destruction.

". . . because you did not recognize the time of God's coming to you." (Luke 19:44)

4th The Future Glory (vv. 25-31)

In the end, things will intensify

His coming = power and great glory

5th The Best Future (vv. 32-38)

The invitation to live verse 34 or 36.

Not = duck & cover; But = watch & pray
