Matthew 25:31-46

The Topic: The eternal destiny of each person

* Sheep — “Come” = Good News

- 1) Freed to serve, no longer motivated by measuring up
- 2) Grateful to God, empathy means “I understand”
- 3) Do this for Jesus, we know who we serve
- 4) Anyone can do it, you don't need a college degree

* Goats — “Depart” = Bad News

- 1) Did not realize their need, how could they recognize the needs of others?
- 2) No benefit, they wouldn't get anything out of it
- 3) Guilty of sin, without a redeemer they were condemned

Pathway to Heaven:

Admit your need for God

Believe in Jesus

Confess your sins

Decide to follow Jesus
