Position Information:

Title: Children's Director

Position Type: 20-30 hours per week

Anticipated Start Date: September 2022

Job Description: New Harvest is seeking a children's director to oversee the children's ministry of the church. The Children's Director will bring leadership to the ongoing ministry of children and families of New Harvest, as well as coordinating outreach opportunities within the local area. The children's ministry currently has over 20 people serving in a variety of capacities. This position will need to work on identifying new team members, while creating pathways for growth and empowerment of those serving. This person must possess strong organization skills, as well as a heart for God, an active walk with Jesus, desire to disciple children and their families, and heart for the lost within the Northeast Salem area.

Responsibilities/Tasks:

- Oversee all parts of children's ministry during weekly church gatherings, including but not limited to curriculum, volunteer support, and teaching.
- In partnership with the Senior Pastor and other staff, develop a strategy for children and their families to become integrated into the life of the church.
- Give vision and direction for the discipleship of children and families in the church.
- Provide oversight for neighborhood outreach and engagement, including existing ministries such as the After-School Program.
- Plan and oversee special events that help bring families from within the church and the community together.
- Develop and utilize a budget for this ministry and give oversight to the use of those resources.

Church Information:

About: Located in Northeast Salem, Oregon, New Harvest Church operates out of a location that has been a beacon of Gospel light since the late 1800s. Having been in existence for 18 years itself, the church is entering into an exciting season of transition involving the Senior Pastor and worship ministry. This worship pastor position will aid in helping the church move forward for years of expanding influence.

With a focus on serving the local community, New Harvest has a strategic partnership with the nearby elementary school, an after-school program, and an ongoing Food Bank. New Harvest is also focused on pointing people to Jesus through Sunday gatherings focused on worship and Bible teaching, as well as weekly small groups and various serving opportunities.
